FINANCIAL UPDATE

For November, Peace had a total income of \$55,843.53 vs a budget of \$55,919.08 or \$75 unfavorable to plan (not a misprint). Pledged giving remained strong as well as recording the PPP grant funding that Peace received. Total expenses for November were \$29,536 vs a budget of \$44,451. However, due to timing of some items that will post in December, this variance will come down a bit. We continue to be blessed with your ongoing support of Peace church.
